Messages in the Xuno app and Xuno **news items** are **translated in real time** into the parent's language of choice, making it **easier** for parents to **stay informed**.

Select Preferred Language

Parents can select from a number of languages to translate school messages and news items. Additional languages can be added as needed.

Respond to Messages in Preferred Language

When parents send a new message or respond to a message on the app in their preferred language, it is translated into English in real time for school staff.

Xuno App or Parent Portal

The translation feature is available to parents in both the Xuno Parent Portal and the Xuno Family App. Parents or staff can select the preferred language for parent communications.
